Dear Mr. Bregy:

I have your enclosure pertaining to the Nevada Lead Group located near Basalt Nevada. We have previously examined the Nevada Lead which tallies exactly with the location of this group and found it to be of no interest. However, if Mr. Wolther writes us we will make sure that it is the same property that we looked at before declining to look at it. So far nothing has been heard from him.

The report on the Castle Rock mine in Eldorado County, Calif. was also received and in going over it we find that the assays are erroneously calculated and his per ton figures should be divided by 3 in a great many cases. Furthermore from his location of the property on his map it would appear that it does not cover the ancient river channel as described by Lingren. I am returning the report as requested but we shall keep it in mind and when Sharp next makes a trip near there he will look it up.

I am also enclosing a report received from Honduras thinking that perhaps whoever is doing the work in Central America could look into it. This letter has not been acknowledged.

Gentlemen:

Replying to your letter of October 6th. Should have answered sooner, as you are aware it takes considerable time to prepare the data and information that you request. I am employed and have to work on it in spare time. I have ample data, but have to copy it from the originals, and just as soon as I can, shall get the information you desire to you.

For your advance information my property is not far from Tonopah, 64 miles west in R 34 - T 2 N 35' - 15" one mile and half of highway leading from Tonopah to Basalt Mineral County, Nevada. I am $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles east of Basalt. The ore consists of Silver-Lead-Gold. A recent general assay gave approximately .25 gold 8 oz. Silver 1.50% lead. This was taken from a big orebody, over an area of about 75 ft. wide 4 ft. deep and 1000 ft. long, the widest point being 581 ft. wide, 320 acres in all.

If you are interested in this character of ore, I will continue to complete the data.
