GEOLOGY: Quartz veins in Rochester Rhyolite and Prida Fm. clastics, strike N40W, dip 65-80° SW. The quartz veins contain stibnite, tetrahedrite, sphalerite, and pyrite plus oxides. The wall rocks are pyritized adjacent to veins and silicified. The veins are narrow, 10-40 cm. Some ore grade material in small stockpile.
