Your letter of May 1, 1958, to Lucius Pitkin, Inc., Grants, New Mexico, has been referred to this office for reply.

The trial shipment which you delivered in November 1957, was accepted so that amenability test work could be done before making further purchases of ore from the Black Bonanza claim.

You will note from the enclosed copy of the amenability test report that your ore is refractory to both acid and carbonate leaching. For this reason, the Commission cannot make any further purchases of ore from this property.

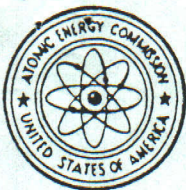
Because of the highly refractory nature of this ore, I cannot suggest a method that could make an economical recovery. The highest extraction achieved by the amenability test is 72.5%, much below the desired recovery in present day uranium mills, and the acid consumption of 100 lbs per ton is considerably higher than generally used throughout
