Report: The mill at Beatty was not a stock proposition,
but privately owned.

The mill was set up at Beatty to take advantage of the weather and labor situation. They processed platinum, gold, and silver. The ore was hauled from Fish Lake Valley in Nevada. The operation was not successful. Later they processed some cinnabar ore from the Beatty area. The ore body did not prove profitable.

In their experimental work they processed about 3 tons a day. They could only handle about 10 tons per day under full operation.
