ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Presently in active, tied up in litigation

GEOLOGY: Met with caretaker Tom Scheetes. Mine is presently being investigated for irregulars activity by Sax of New York. Gold and Silver locked up in pyrite rich quartz vein. Material intruding in *granodiorite. At least 2000 ft. of workings, houses; last year nearly drilled at least 3000 ft. Current mill not designed to handle oxidized and fresh ore simultaneously ore is crystalline sulfide and occur in pods, stringers, and disseminated throughout quartz vein.
