DEVELOPMENT: The Goldquartz mine has been changed to a open-pit operation with good roads and leaching facility. An extensive drilling operation has been done on the property to define the ore bodies.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: The mine is currently in a holding operation awaiting the recovery of gold prices?

GEOLOGY: The mine is in a highly altered Slaven Chert which has been intruded by several different rock types including; Rhyolite dikes, breccia pipes? and quartz veins. The open pit must be very close to the Tertiary granitic contact although it was not observed in the pit or the wall rocks.

Sample 679 was of brecciated chert with some silica in the matrix.
