DEVELOPMENT: Several very large adits and one shaft.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Slaven Chert and Valmey which is completely deformed by thrusting, folding and faulting. Fractures and or faults have been intruded by a very large vein system composed of quartz, gouge etc.

The source of the veins and mineralization is thought to be the granite of Bullion Mt., although it does not outcrop at the surface. The principle vein structure strikes N 45 W and dips irregularly. The beds which are completely altered cherts are highly fractured providing an excellent conduit for the ascending ore solutions. Mineralization in the faults and vein system within the main adit and dump were sampled 676.
