ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Folded, faulted, and deformed by thrusting and intrusives, are a complex of cherts shales and quartzites of the Valmey and Slaven Chert Formations. The mine is just north of the Silver Prize and Grand Prize, and is probably part of the same vein system but has somewhat different intrusives and mineralization.

There are some darker dike materials present in the incline that was not observed at the other workings.
