ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drilling and later leaching.

GEOLOGY: The entire mine is in the granitic stock which is composed of both quartz monzonite and granodiorite with minor aplite, rhyolite and darker dikes. The granite is hydrothermally altered along quartz vein structures which have intruded joints and other fractures.

REMARKS: I examined the upper spanish stope and dump I found extensive mineralization associated with hydrothermal quartz veins. A wide variety of minerals were observed and sampled #685.
