GEOLOGY: Site is medium sized (or over sized small) open pit with several levels going into a FeOx - limonite stained shear zone. Dump composed of medium grey, sand-sized grains of quartzite, highly fractured with turquoise coating fracture up to 2 mm wide scattered. Minor oxidized pyrite & chalcopryrite. Some silicified limestone breccia also with turquoise & sulfides area is huge. Shear zone of thinly bedded quartzite & silicified Limestone with bedded folded & faulted

Additional working across drainage and surrounding hills. Probably at least 10 miles of drill/prospect roads in area.
