GEOLOGY: Claims series of shallow shafts, prospect pits (many more than shown on map), following shallow dipping quartz veins cutting the Triassic Candelaria Formation. Host rock silty shales bearing oxidized pyrite crystals up to 1/8". Formation also possibly cut with fine grained intrusive. Fe-Mn stains. Vein material is white, crystalline to massive, vuggy quartz with a horizontal to shallow dip southeast. Minor copper coated exposed and fracture surfaces in the workings at the crest of the hill. Most of the shafts are shallow and appear to be for exploration only, with little or no production.
