two inclines, a tunnel and crosscuts

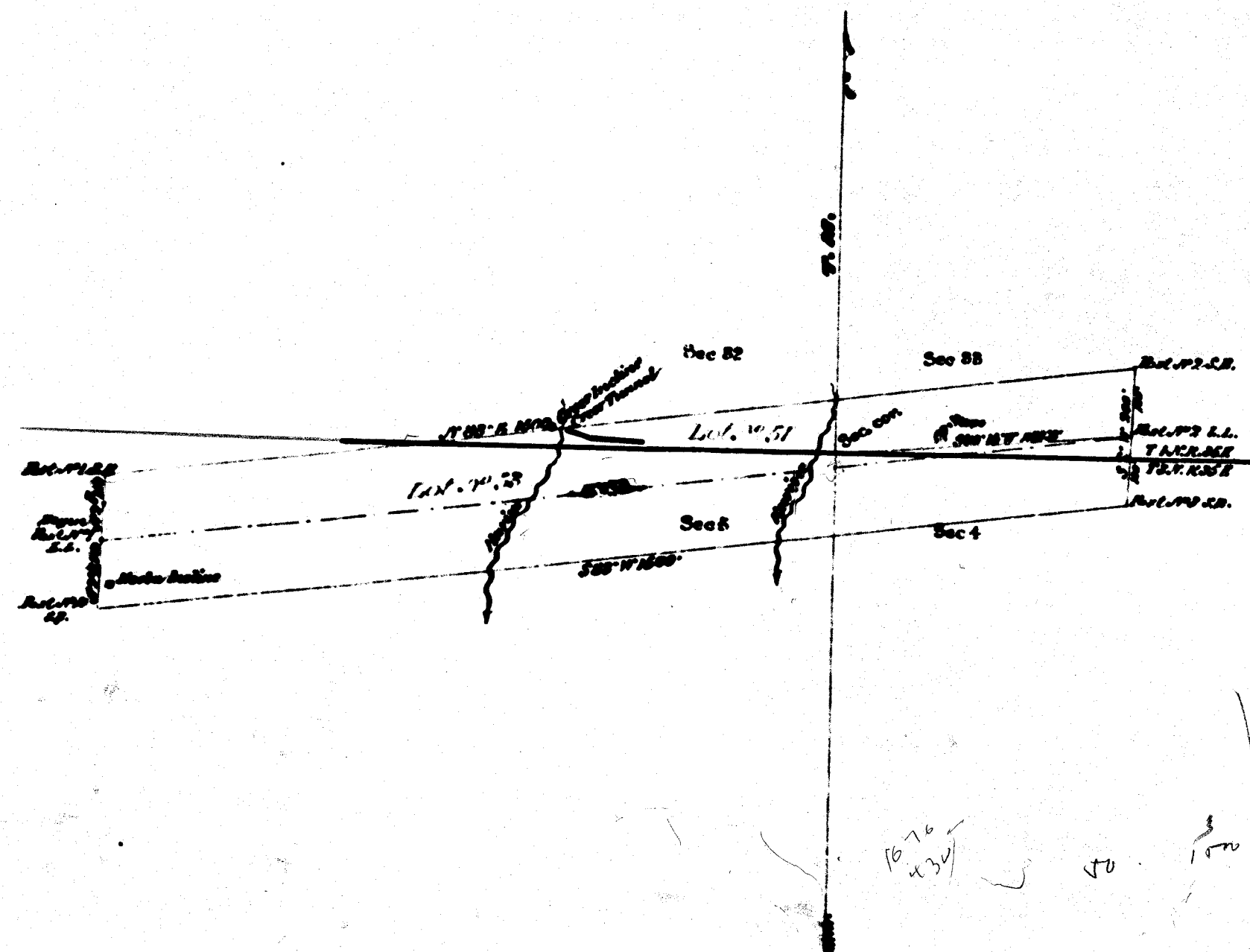
