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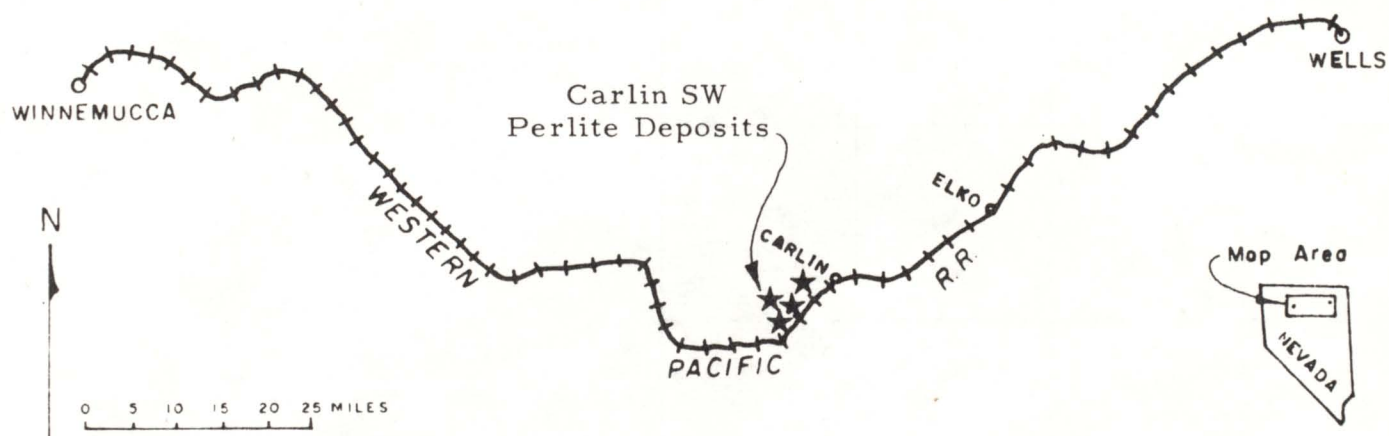

in E 1/2, SE 1/4, Sec. 11; small outcrop of perlite
in Sec. 9; perlite in both sections locally overlain by
tuff, welded tuff, sand and gravel.
Conclusion: shows limited promise
