DEVELOPMENT: The western 1/2 of sec. 34, T32N, R52E & the central portion of sec. 4, T31N, R52E are developed by numerous exploration cuts & drill (?) roads. The roads appear to be 5-10 years old or older.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Road cuts on west side of canyon were examined. The rocks exposed along the road consist of a bedded sequence of limey siltstones, silty limestones & black shales. The rocks are fractured, brecciated & cemented & veined by crystalline calcite & barite.

Dick Jones believes that this exploration work was done by Union Carbide for Vanadium. Some bagged cuttings(?) were found on the road, but no drill holes were observed.
