DEVELOPMENT: A few old dirt roads. CRIB notes trenching, but none was observed.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None. Most recent activity is staking of Ira claims.

GEOLOGY: We never found a prospect in this area, only a few roads up the canyon. However, we did sample a resistant, silicified, barite veined knob which protruded from a section of bleached & oxidized siltstones & shales. The knob was composed of a shale/siltstone breccia cemented & veined by silica, FeOxs & barite. The outcrop probably lies on a fault which strikes approximately N10E (This is general trend of resistant outcrop). Some fluorite(?) may be present with the barite in irregular pods & on fracture surfaces. Yellow oxides may be limonite or possibly carnotite(?).

NBMG Bull 81 cites this as a uranium prospect.

Our sample was collected about 1/5 mile north of prospect location cited in attached Uranium occurrence report. Old dozer cuts are cited in the uranium write-up indicating it is a better location for the Deerhead prospect. See Uranium report for additional sample & site information.
