### GENERAL BACKGROUND

The Castle Peak area is located in the Virginia Range, approximately 10 miles north of Virginia City. The only important mine in the district is the Castle Peak Mine located in section 20, T. 18 N., R. 21 E. This mine is not in the Pyramid Resource Area. A portion of the district overlaps into the area of this report, and because mercury mineralization may be present in this overlapping area, the district has been included in this report.

Over 2,576 flasks of mercury have been produced from the Castle Peak Mine, but there has been no apparent production from the lands within the Pyramid Resource Area. The area was not examined by the writers and subsequent discussion will include only that portion of the district within the resource area.

## GEOLOGICAL AND TECHNICAL DATA

Volcanic flows and breccias of the Alta and Kate Peak Formations crop out extensively in the area. Portions of the Alta Formation have been highly altered and could be favorable sites for mercury mineralization.

### POTENTIAL FOR DEVELOPMENT

It is unlikely that the portion of the district within the Pyramid Resource Area will be a producer of mercury in the future.


