Examined this one with Ralph Taylor on
September 23, 1940. Located at 10.5 miles
from Reno, the concentrating plant prepares
ore mined by shovel and hauled by truck from
Washington Hill, 5.3 miles to the southeast.
Concentration has a ratio of about 100 to 1,
and concentrates are furnaced at Castle Peak.

Further interest depended onsamples. These were poor. The zone of mineralization was very extensive and characterized by masses of opalite and could be traced for many thousands of feet. However material was definitely minus one pound. Property was in litigation. Went out with Mr. Louefeck.
