
I leave for Australia September 20th returning sometime the first week in October. I will telephone you during the week of September 13th.





Dear Fred: With time of the essence, the attached map and comments is being sent in duplicate. The 'special' to your home address should assure your having these thoughts before your departure for Australia. The area picked for soil sampling can be seen on your set of 2000 scale maps, both by the pattern of the Geiger Grade and via the common corner of sections 35, 36, 1 and 2. The grid shows sample sites based on 200 foot centers which total 122. In reply, finally, to your query re: 100 foot centers, it would appear that sites would total 210, adding even more to the estimate which, unfortunately, is exceeded by the 200 scale spacing. The grid has been chosen, as shown, because of northeastsouthwest structures, mapped on the Geiger grade, which appear to control the better-than-average heavy ferrous oxidation. Using \$3.50 per sample for mercury and arsenic values. (Quist has upped his original estimate of several months ago. but I hope to still get it down a bit), the cost of analyses would amount to \$427. Considering our experience of the summer of 1970, using two men, my guess is that surveying and cutting samples by myself will not provide more than fifteen samples per day. The proceedure would, therefore, require eight days. Therefore, in considering the 3000 by 1400 foot area, we are ndw looking at an estimate of about \$1300. To stay within the original \$750 estimate, sampling would have to be reduced to about 70 logations. This could be done by skipping every-other NW-SE line; on the 50% of cross-sections used, samples would be taken at the planned 200 foot intervals. Such would provide aseries of true profiles across the treds of the indicated mineral gove I would suggest this alternative and then, assuming meaningful results, the gaps could be filled in at a later date, if so desired. It is planned to be in town until your departure. Comments and instructions would be appreciated. Yurs very truly, David LeCount Evans

I am leaving town at 5 AM on Tuesday, for purposes of looking over three gold possibilities in northwestern California. The chances are that I will be back in Reno on the 13th, and certainly not later than the 14th.

Inasmuch as it is planned to be in the Boondox and away from any permanent telephone, it has occured to me that this letter is in order, and possibly will be of help.

As you know Dale Armastrong was in town on Thursday and Friday, and in that two days did an excellent jobs of assembling the information desired. Very much appreciated was the fact that he went out of his way to keep me completely posted on the results. This has made possible the enclosed plat of the immediate Geiger area; the other two areas in sections 5 and 6 in Twp. 17 N. Rge. 21 E, and sections 32 and 33 in Twp. 18 N, and Range 21 East, have not been drafted, since this is an holiday and I do not have access to Zerok services. The fact that both are Fee in the possession of one owner, would, perhaps, make a plat unnecessary.

My feeling is that what Dale has come up with, 'opens the door'. In the Geiger area, that some of real interest we find open, and available for entry; this I have colored in solid yellow; the area, cross-hatched in yellow, is all fee acreage, probably available through negotiation, and desireable for protection and possible extension.

Concerning my map, bear in mind that such is a first reaction and open to adjustment. Note that I have covered the open
zone with north-south arranged claims, totalling 15; the alternative was also tried, using east-west orientation, with a three claimwidth, with widths of 450,500, and 550; this arrangement totalled
17. The first approach is preferred since it is two less, and would
be easier to locate and stake.

In they event one would wish to proceed with establishing claims, the following steps are listed:

step #1: making locations: preferably at the center of each claim. Discovery monuments can be (a) a tree, 4" or more in diamenter, cut off 3 feet above ground; (b) a rock mound atop a rock in place, also three feet high, (c) or a 4" x 4" post, 4½ long with one foot in the ground.

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
I believe that this letter is far too long, but in rereading it, feel that it presents some food for thought.



You referred to me the enclosed letter of Nevada State Inspector of Mines Harry E. Springer asking you if the recently enacted Nevada AB-766 "would have the apparent acquiescence and sanction of the United States government in accordance with Federal Mining discovery and location laws?" It is well established that a State may legislate with respect to the location and maintenance of mining claims on Federal lands, subject to mining location where the Federal Government has not legislated thereon, by law or regulation, or to the extent that the State legislation is not in conflict with the Federal mining laws or mining regulations. I find nothing in the revisions of the Nevada mining laws, as enacted by AB-766, which conflicts with the Federal mining laws and/or regulations.

The revisions of the Nevada mining laws, as enacted by AB-766, provide for the filing with the county recorder of maps and other documents concerning mining claims; supplying new specifications for claim markers; requiring certain written and recorded information regarding the resumption of assessment work after failure to do so; penalty for willfully and knowingly making a false material statement on the location certificate or map required by the law; and adjusting filing fees.

The United States mining laws provide specifically that local laws shall govern with respect to "the location, manner of recording, amount of work necessary to hold possession of a mining claim", subject only to certain requirements as specified in the Federal law. See 30 U.S.C. sec. 28. The Act of September 2, 1958 (72 Stat. 1701; 30 U.S.C. sec. 28-1) specifies what shall be included in the "annual assessment report" required to be recorded in the local county office. The United States mining laws have been construed by many court decisions to mean that a State may legislate with respect to the location and maintenance of mining claims on Federal lands, subject to mining location, where the Federal Government has not legislated thereon, by law or regulation, or to the extent that the State legislation is not in conflict with the Federal mining laws and/or mining regulations. See 30 U.S.C.A. 28, Notes 61 et seq.

I find nothing in the revisions of the Nevada mining laws, as enacted by AB-766, which conflicts with the Federal mining laws or regulations (43 CFR, Parts 3840 et seq.). However, it should be noted that the Nevada mining laws provide that unless a mining claim is located and

recorded in accordance therewith it shall be "absolutely void". The Department of the Interior has held that the Federal Government may not "void" a mining claim merely because notice thereof was not recorded or that it had not been staked or monumented in accordance with State law. The Department has held that a failure to comply with State laws as to posting or recording notices of location, staking or monumenting claims, or sinking discovery shafts "would be material only in a proceeding where adverse claimants to the same land are endeavoring to establish the superiority of their respective claims to the possession of the ground in conflict."

The Interior Department "voids", by appropriate proceedings, a mining claim only for the failure of the mining claimant to perfect his claim by making a "valid discovery" within the limits of the claim, for the claimant's "abandonment" of a claim, or because the land was not subject to mining location when the claim was located. The fallure of a mining claimant to comply with the Nevada laws on "staking or monumenting claims", "posting", "recording notices of location", "failure to do the annual assessment work" (unless such continued failure amounts to abandonment), "sinking discovery shafts", or "filing the map" would not "void" the claim insofar as the Federal Government is concerned. However, such failure may "void" the possessory right and title of the defaulting claimant and subject the land to a new location by another claimant. Any controversy as to which claimant is entitled to the possession of the claim would have to be settled by the local courts.

Dear Mr. Barton:

This is in reply to your inquiry of May 26, 1971 requesting an interpretation of Nevada Mining Law (A.B. 766).

The questions you propose are as follows:

- 1. What is the scope of responsibility of county recorders in implimenting A.B. 766 (Chapter 680, 1971 Statutes of Nevada)?
- 2. What are the specific requirements for charging fees?
- 3. What must be filed to have a legal recording of a certificate of location?
- 4. Where does responsibility lie for the county claim map?

The county recorder's responsibility under the new law is essentially unchanged from that prior to this law. The recorder is obligated to see that the proper fee is tendered with two copies of the location certificate which appears on its face to meet the requirements of NRS 517.050, and two copies of a map that appears on its face to meet the requirements of NRS 517.030.

The recorder has no obligation to verify the truth of any statement made on a location certificate or verify the accuracy of any location map. On the location certificate the recorder should merely check to see that name of the claim, name and address of the locator, date, et cetera are on the location certificate. On the location map the recorder should merely check to see that it is identified and that it shows the township, range and section or if the land is unsurveyed, a statement to that effect in lieu of the section number. Recorders should also advise the locators that if the map does not properly set forth the boundaries and location of their claims, they are not in compliance with the statute. The county surveyor will notify the locator if the recorded map does not comply with the statute.

The recorders have no responsibility for preparation of the county claim map beyond the requirement that they forward the one copy of the recorded maps and certificates of location to the county surveyor. In the event there is no county surveyor, the maps and certificates should be submitted to the county commissioners until they appoint a surveyor as required by NRS 255.040 and 245.170 as follows:

NRS 255.040 reads as follows:
"Vacancies in the office of county surveyor shall be filled as in the case of other county officers."

NRS 245.170 reads as follows:

"When any vacancy shall exist or occur in any county or township office, except the office of district judge and county commissioner, the board of county commissioners shall appoint some suitable person, an elector of the county, to fill such vacancy until the next ensuing biennial election."

The fees that recorders are required to charge are chargeable upon filing of the certificate of location and location map as required by NRS 517.030. The fees to be charged are as follows:

1. Location of Lode Claim \$15.00 per claim NRS 517.040 2. Relocation of Lode Claim \$20.00 per claim NRS 517.080

3. Location of Placer Claim \$ 1.00 per acre NRS 517.100

4. Location of Mill Site \$15.00 per claim NRS 517.140 & 517.040 5. Location of Tunnel Right \$15.00 per claim NRS 517.170 & 517.040

There is no statutory requirement for an additional fee to be charged for filing assessment maps required pursuant to NRS 517.230. It should also be noted that the fees required by A.B. 766 are in addition to the customary recording fees charged by recorders.

In order for a locator to perfect a valid location pursuant to the new state law, he must in addition to the on-site work required file two copies of the certificate of location, two copies of a map meeting the requirements of NRS 517.030 and the proper fee as above noted. Anything offered for recording that does not fully comply with this should not be accepted by recorders for the purpose of complying with the mining laws.

The county mining claim map is clearly the sole responsibility of the county surveyor as provided in NRS 255.110, subsection 1 (d) as follows:

"Obtain maps of mining claims, mill sites and tunnel rights filed with the county recorder and prepare a county mining claim map which shall accurately reflect the location of all such claims."

If the county surveyor refuses to perform his duties, there is a statutory penalty in NRS 255.140 for neglect of duties, as follows:

"Any county surveyor who shall fail or refuse to perform any of the duties required of him by this chapter shall be fined by any court of competent jurisdiction in a sum not exceeding \$500."

The county commissioners are required to provide compensation to the county surveyor for duties he is required to perform under NRS 255.060 which reads as follows:

"The board of county commissioners shall allow to each county surveyor fair and reasonable compensation, in lieu of salary, in connection with each survey order by the board, or for such other services performed by

him for the county, when he has been authorized to perform the same."

It is the intent of A.B. 766 that it generate adequate funds to sustain its administration, however, its fee requirements are specific and the services demanded of the county are specific. If there is a disparity between the income derived and the expenses incurred it will inure to the county, be it an asset or a liability.

If location maps are submitted for recording which do not "properly set forth the boundaries and location of his claim" as required by NRS 517.030 and NRS 517.040, then the surveyor should so notify the locator. Even though the locator has his map in the record, he has not complied with the statutes where the map does not "properly set forth the boundaries and location of his claim". It is intended that the location map be such that the surveyor can plot the claim on the county mining claim map.

"Guidelines for Preparing Mining Claim Maps Required by the New Nevada Mining Claim Laws," a leaflet designed to provide assistance in making mining claim maps under new laws set down by the recent Nevada Legislature, has been issued by the Nevada Bureau of Mines and Geology, University of Nevada, it was announced this week.

The guidelines are intended to be used in conjunction with Assembly Bill 766, the actual law, and an earlier pamphlet, "Questions and Answers Concerning the New Nevada Mining Claim Laws," released by the Nevada Bureau of Mines and Geology in July.

The new one-sheet publication explains 16 essential points to be noted by map makers before filing location claims with a County Recorder. It is being offered by the State Bureau to assist claim locators in preparing maps which properly set forth the boundaries and location of their claims.

The Bureau points out that a claim map must be accurate so that a County Surveyor can plot it on the County's master claim map, which is also now required by law. Once the master map has been compiled to include all available information on mining claims in a County, it will be useful to both the individual and the State. Among other things, it will help to keep track of where principal mineral exploration is being conducted and prevent litigation resulting from unintentional overlap of claims.

### GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING MINING CLAIM MAPS White was been muliqued and has been REQUIRED BY

### THE NEW NEVADA MINING CLAIM LAWS make your survey accumulaly, you can be sure that your claim will be corteet when plotted on the map.

This leaflet has been prepared to provide a detailed checklist of the things that are required of maps filed with Nevada County Recorders to perfect mining claim locations

under the new Nevada statutes.

The problem that we hope to avoid with these guidelines is this: the statutes require that the claim locator's map shall "...properly set forth the boundaries and location of his claim," and the statutes also require that the County Surveyor, using these maps, shall "...prepare a county mining claim map which shall accurately reflect the location of all such claims." In order to make the county mining claim map, the County Surveyor must be able to plot the claims on that map, using the map that you, as the locator, have submitted. If he cannot plot your claims, then your map has not satisfied the law, in that you have not completed your location work as required by the statute. The County Recorder cannot tell you, at the time you file your map, whether it satisfies the law, because he is not

These guidelines are intended to be used in conjunction with AB 766, the actual laws themselves, and with the earlier pamphlet, "Questions and Answers concerning the New Mining Claim Laws," which contains most of the general statements concerning the new law. A few of the guidelines set down here are different from answers to questions in the "Questions and Answers" pamphlet; in such cases, these guidelines should be used, rather than the pamphlet.

If you are in doubt about whether your claim map has everything that is needed, take it to your County Surveyor before you record it; he will be able to tell you quickly.

1. All writing on the map must be legible. Printing is

usually better than script.

2. The map should be either 8½ inches by 14 inches, or else 24 inches by 32 inches. The County Recorders cannot fit into their files maps that are larger, smaller, or in between these sizes. (Note that this is more specific than the dimensions that were given in the

Questions and Answers pamphlet.)

Of the two maps that you must file, one copy should be on transparent material such as polyester film. acetate film, tracing linen, or good-quality tracing paper. The second can be a blueprint or black-line print from the transparency. A transparency is needed because copies must sometimes be made from the map in the Recorder's files, and also, these materials are more durable than most ordinary paper.

The map should be drawn either in ink, or with a 4. hard, sharp pencil, so that it will stay legible in the

- The title block of the map must show the following 5. information:
  - The name of the claim group (such as "Map of the Ace No. 1 thru 3 Group of Lode Claims") or else a list of the claims shown (such as "Map of the Ace, King, Queen, and Jack Lode Claims).

(b) The kind of claims, either Lode (as above), Placer, Mill Site, or Tunnel Right.

The Township, Range and Section, the Mining (c)

District (if the claims are located within a recognized district), and the County that the claims are in.

(d) The name and post office address of the locator.

The date the claims were located.

At the bottom edge of the map, there must be a clear space at least 3 inches by 3 inches, for the Recorder's stamp.

The statutes require a scale of at least 1 inch equals 500 feet. The County Surveyors recommend a scale of 1 inch equals 300 feet, which complies with the statutes, and gives more room for notations.

Somewhere on the map must be stated the scale that is used, for example, "Scale 1 inch equals 300 feet" or "Scale 1" = 300'."

Somewhere on the map must be an arrow pointing to north, and this must be labeled either "True North" or "Magnetic North," whichever is the case.

The name of each claim must be written inside each claim. If you have located a group all using the same name, with numbers, like the Ace No. 1 thru 3 Group, above, just No. 1, No. 2, etc. with the name indicated only once will be sufficient.

The location monument should be labeled, and the number of each corner of the claim must be shown. It would be useful to state somewhere on the map the description of the corners, for instance, "all corners

are 4 x 4 wooden posts."

Around the outside boundary of the claim group, you should write the bearing and distance of the line from each corner to the next one. For example, along the west side of a claim, between one corner and the side center, you might write "N 35° E 750'," and between that side center and the next corner, again "N 35° E 750'," and between that corner and the next one, S 55° E 600'." This is so the Surveyor can plot the claim accurately. If you have only one claim, you put the bearings and distances along each side and end. If you have a group of contiguous claims, you only need to do it along the edges of the group; the Surveyor can use these bearings and distances to plot the inside claims of the group accurately. (This recommendation was not included in the Questions and Answers pamphlet.)

At least one corner on the outside boundary of the claim group must be surveyed, in accordance with your abilities but accurately, either to a section corner or to a claim location marker, and this survey must be shown on your map. If the survey is just a single straight line, you can use an arrow, writing in the bearing and distance, as was done on the sample map in the Questions and Answers booklet. If you have to survey a zigzag line to the section corner or claim location marker, you must show the survey on the map, writing the bearings and distances of each segment of it as you did around the outside boundary

of the claim group.

It is worth spending even 2 or 3 days to find a section corner near enough to survey to, because then if you make your survey accurately, you can be sure that your claim will be correct when plotted on the map. If you cannot find a section corner, you must then build a claim location marker, as stipulated in the statutes, and show on your map the survey from one claim corner on the outside boundary to the claim location marker (you should also put on the map the statement "Section corner searched for but not found."). The claim location marker is not a claim location monument. The claim location monument is the same claim location monument that the law has always required, and still requires, for each claim. The claim location marker is a separate monument which must be either a rock monument 4 feet in diameter and 4 feet high, or else a steel post or pipe 3 inches in diameter projecting 5 feet above the ground, placed in some prominent point visible from at least one claim corner. Only one claim location marker is needed, and the same one can serve for several different claim groups, even if they have different owners.

15. If a claim location marker is used, the map must have on it a complete description of where the marker is with respect to natural or man made features that are shown on some readily available map, such as the




U. S. Geological Survey topographic maps, or the U. S. Bureau of Land Management grazing district quadrangles, and the description must say exactly which published map the features are on. This is so that the County Surveyor can get that map, see exactly where your claim location marker is, and then pinpoint it on the county claim map; unless he can do that, he cannot plot your claims. A typical description of a claim location marker might read, "The claim location marker is a 3 inch iron pipe filled with concrete, set in the saddle 3,000' N 35° W from Willow Spring, approximately in unsurveyed Section 17, Township 20 North, Range 37 East, as shown on the 1966 edition of the Clan Alpine Ranch topographic quadrangle published by the U. S. Geological Survey." Another typical description might read, "The claim location marker is a 4' dry rock monument in Section 32, Township 31 N, Range 31 East (no section corners can be found), 200' south of the road intersection shown in this section on U. S. Bureau of Land Management Map No. 42, 'Pyramid Grazing District, Virginia City Grazing District,' dated 1951.'

16. If you know where adjacent older claims lie, you should show them on your map where they come close to your claims, drawing them with dashed lines and writing in their names (and ownership if possible). This will help keep unreal overlaps or open fractions out of the county claim map, when the County Surveyor plots your claims. statements concerning the new law. A few of the guidelines
