ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: The claim block is a series of adits on an east facing ridge in Box Canyon (name?). The only significant workings is the adit at the mouth of the canyon where the fault zone (S35W, 38 NW) is prominent. Tailings from the adit show hematite after pyrite mineralization. No other mineralization is apparent. Fault zone is brecciated and silicified while the overlying rock is cherty. Fe-stained Limestone with quartz veining and numerous gasteroids, crinoids and coral.

The rest of the property up the canyon have no evidence of mineralizations, large tailings consist of silicified Limestone.
