DEVELOPMENT: 2 small prospects. Old Workings

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Ls host rock bedding is oriented N5E, low SE(?) and is cut by N50W, vertical shear zone characterized by breccia & Feox staining.

Rock on dump is a gossany, replaced silicified ls & ls breccia which is cemented by Fe stained quartz &/or calcite. Ls along shear is thoroughly altered & has a ribboned lufinid appearance. No mineralization observed in dump rocks.

Probably in G ls as shown on county geol. map.

REMARKS: Sample 274 - select grab from dump of gossany altered ls breccia with calcite veining & thoroughly silicified & Fe stained ls breccia with quartz veining. No mineralization observed.
