DEVELOPMENT: Open cut on vein, roads, considerable wagon drilling on vein.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, drilling done previous year.

GEOLOGY: Brecciated quartzite, cemented by vein quartz, breccia zone N5°-10° W, near vertical, s/ 25' wide appears to parallel bedding vein zone vuggy, vugs lined with acicular quartz crystals, hematite, limonite, some small flecks free gold. Quartzite unit overlain by fissile, tan and grey mottled shale, then a thin-bedded grey limestone, strike N5°W, 35° west dip.

REMARKS: Entire knob or point above and in from of small pit has been drilled on close spacing, as if for blasting.
