Cleve Creek (Half Moon and Kolchek) - CLEVE CREEK DAST,

Schoolite in quarts is found at 2 adjacest localities on the South Fork of Cleve Creek in the Shell Creek Range. At the Half Moon prospect, discovered by Hadley R. Bramel, about 1,000 feet north of the Kolchek cabins, ore estimated at 0.5 percent of WOg is found in a body 20 fest long and 10 feet wide at the contact between the Cambrian Pioche shale and overlying limestone. At the Kolchek prospect, 1,000 feet west of the cabins, large crystals of scheelite in an area 30 feet long and 20 feet wide are present in a quarts vein formerly worked for gold. The country rock is Cambrian limestone.
