

GEOLOGY: Brecciated welded tuff, with some pale white fluorite and iron oxides in matrix, structure not well exposed, but trenching follows N3O-40W trend. Welded tuff exposed in the trenchs is sericitized, contains phenocrysts of smokey quartz and sanadine in a kaolinized, sericitized ground mass. Altered zone appears to be along the flank of an obsidian-rich dome or plug which lies to the north of the prospects.
