GEOLOGY: Adit is difficult to locate because it is surrounded by dense riparian vegetation.  
The only clue to its actual location was the presence of a minor amount of timber & dump  
rock at the nonexistent portal.

The dump rock consists of siltstone(prob.Mc\*), some minor breccia & secondary quartz  
on fractures. No mineralization or even hint of activity observed.
