TO THE CREDITORS AND OTHER PARTIES IN INTEREST:

Foley, United Stated District Judge, United States Courthouse, Las Vegas, Nevada, Paul Gemmill, duly-appointed, qualified and acting receiver of Grand Deposit Mining Company, one of the above-named defendants, will call up for hearing his receiver's report respecting Grand PanAm Joint Venture, to-wit:

- 1. Combined Metals Reduction Company and Grand Deposit Mining Company entered into a joint venture agreement to develop certain mining properties and leases, operating under the fictitious name of Grand PanAm Company.
- 2. The joint venture's principle asset, a lease on the Pan-American Mine, Lincoln County, Nevada, was terminated and all claims and disputes related thereto were settled and approved by the court in the Grand Deposit Mining Company proceedings, No. LV 1221.
- 3. An analysis of the accounts payable of the joint venture reflects that the sum of \$2,656.96 is due the Grand Deposit Mining Company from the estate of Combined Metals Reduction Company. All other financial obligations of the joint venture have been met.
- 4. Receiver recommends the approval of the receiver's report.
