

"TOPOGRAPHIC MAP... OF THE SULTRO (sic) TUNNEL
AND THE COMSTOCK LODGE" Chas. F. Hoffman

Very rare and early map of the Comstock. Dated 1866, but must be from about 1871 because of the Virginia and Truckee Railroad, Sutro Townsite, and actual location of the Sutro Tunnel. Our guess is that this map was copied from an earlier map and possibly published by Sutro in London while he was raising money for the tunnel project.

This is one of only a few in existence that show the Gould and Curry Mill, Johntown site, Dayton to Virginia Toll House, and other early geographic locales left off of later maps.
