The Salmon district is 60 miles north of Toano, on the Salmon Falls River in the vicinity of which are some very fine agricultural lands. It was organized during the fall of 1872, by Mæssrs. Hanks, Noll and Lewis. The ores are principally copper, some of which have been shipped to San Francisco. There is a good natural road from the district to the railroad.
