DEVELOPMENT: Sampled location is an open S60W directed adit. Across canyon to east there are several other adits, mostly caved.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, although ground is probably patented.

GEOLOGY: Adit sampled explores quartz monzonite outcrop which displays a well-developed, blocky joint system which dips 60° S. Rock sampled from dump is vein material. It consists of a finely crystalline mixture of pyrite, galena and sphalerite in a gangue of quartz & cut by secondary quartz veinlets. The vein material obviously comes from depth as it is not exposed at portal.
