DEVELOPMENT: Several adits, rock cabin,

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Ridges above cabin, drilled and trenched within last 1-2 years

GEOLOGY: Workings appear to be along the contact between a Cretaceous intrusive and the (quartz monzonite?) PG biotite granitic gneiss. Fresh and oxidized sulfides, predominantly chalcopryrite with pyrite, occur as veinlets, pods, and individual grains in the fine to medium grained gneiss. Argillic alteration along with abundant Fe-Mn oxides stain the surfaces of exposed. Gneiss are cut with very fine quartz veinlets, and the sulfides appear to be even more finely disseminated in the very fine biotite flakes.
