ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION:

GEOLOGY: The Mg deposits in the Currant District were not well studied in this project for various reasons. The main reason is the reference cited below is written specifically about these deposits. The Rigsby deposit was the only Mg occurrence visited and photographed.

The Windows Mine (Badger Hot Spring) was posted as private property/no trespassing during July 1981. A short write-up from NBMG Bull. 65 is attached to the crib form. A write-up from this bull. is also attached to the crib form. Ala-mar deposit is easily accessible by dirt road from highway 6.

Several Mg deposits are located within T12N, R59E (north of the Ala-mar working) in the Currant Mtn. 15' quad. An attempt was made to visit these workings but the roads to them were washed out making them inaccessible by car.
