GEOLOGY: The mineralized zone is a 2-3 m wide siliceous gossan, due N, 90 .
Argillically altered Tertiary rhyolite porphyry (sampled) was found on the dump and in
nearby outcrop-apparently a dike. The wallrock is Paleozoic carbonate rocks.

REMARKS: Photo 10 in roll 2 shows the rib of siliceous gossan, the shaft collar, and the
white rhyolite porphyry on dump. Sample 426, grab of rhyolite porphyry on dump.
