DEVELOPMENT: Two adits, est. each 50?m long.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The workings explore a N25W, 50 SW breccia zone in gray, massive Paleozoic limestone. The zone is an average of 75cm wide, and consists of a silicified breccia of silicified limestone and white vein quartz. White cockade quartz is present locally; also a "stockwork" of 1mm white quartz veinlets in fractured limestone. The ore is apparently all oxidized (one little piece of sphalerite? was seen). The ore was apparently a siliceous gossan, and probably contained supergene Pb, Zn & Ag minerals. Slickensides noted on the vein margin (possibly post ore) were seen both raking 10° SW and 60° NW in the breccia zone prospects on hill to southeast are probably along the same trend. Presumably this zone is the Vestal Shear.

REMARKS: Photo 11 roll 2, is of adit portal on northside of road.
