DEVELOPMENT: Numerous old pits cuts, adits, drill sites from recent (1970's) drill program by Mine Finders, Inc.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Property covers area of rolling juniper - covered hills, mostly limestone outcrops, old workings appear to date from late 1920's - early 1930's.

At Job #47 location monument (Sample 002), three shallow shafts have been sunk on N50 W, 75 NE dipping fault zone, silicified limestone on NE side of fault, bedded volcanics and sediments to NW tuffs strike N50 W, dip 45 - 50 SW. Jasper and silica cemented rubble occurs along the fault. "Vein" along fault consists of tan and red - brown Jasper, silica-cemented rubble with calcite and drusy silica coatings.
