Fresh dozer work (1980) has destroyed evidence of old workings. Massive red-brown and brown jasperoid seen on dump. Ore fragments seen were completely oxidized, cross-fractures filled with silica, wall rock sugary, bleached limestone X-crossed with silica and calcite veinlets. Open pit exposes flat lying ore bed, shows gentle fold in wall of pit. A lense of cherty limestone above ore horizon is extremely fractured.
