GEOLOGY: Bedding N20W, 34SW, possibly thrust sheet evidenced by milky white quartz phyllite interbedded, pods of waxy, green mineral. Dump mostly phyllitic sheets, quartzite, and bull quartz. Minerals - galena, malachite, bronchantite, anglesite, Fe-Mg stained.

REMARKS: Site consists of that noted above 2 ore chutes, 50-75 year old stone building with out roof.
