REMARKS:

Several thousand of underground workings, 2 adits, ore chute, $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ acres of dump, old building, another smaller one, probably 50 years.

Several miles of road work.

Mine appear to be where a small block of Vinini Fm O/C implying that mineralization resulted from gravity slide of Roberts Mtn. Thrust.
