GEOLOGY: Mixture of volcanic rocks. Basically andesitic composition, but much glassy material, fair amount rhyolitic material, lots of lithic fragments. Granite contact is probably less than 1/2 mi. to the west. Fair amount of dark colored glassy vol. brecc. Mineralization occurs in this breccia.
