To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two, and legislation supplemental thereto, there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Field Notes of Survey and the Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Carson City, Nevada, accompanied by other evidence whereby it appears that the Western Divide Mining and Milling Company has entered and paid for the Nonpareil No. 5; Nonpareil No. 6; Nonpareil No. 7; Nonpareil No. 8; Nonpareil No. 9; Nonpareil No. 10; and Nonpareil No. 11, lode mining claims, designated by the Surveyor General as Survey No. 4437, embracing a portion of Sections twenty-seven, twenty-eight, thirty-three, and thirty-four in Township two north of Range forty-two east of the Mount Diablo Meridian, in the Gold Mountain Mining District, Esmeralda County, Nevada, and bounded, described, and platted as follows: Beginning for the description of the Nonpareil No. 5, lode claim at corner No. 1, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked LNP5, LNP6, 2NP7, 2NP8-4437, in mound of earth and stone; from which the southeast corner of Section twenty-eight in Township two north of Range forty-two east of the Mount Diablo Meridian, bears north seventy-one degrees eighteen minutes east five hundred seventy-three and two-tenths feet distant;

Thence, first course, north eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which location post bears south three minutes west twenty-six feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No. 2, a pine post four inches square, two and one half feet above ground, marked 2NP5, 2NP6-4437, LNP5, LNP4-4436 in mound of earth and stone; identical with corners Nos. 1, of the Nonpareil No. 3, and Nonpareil No. 4, lode claims Survey No. 4436;

Thence, second course, south three minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 3, a pine post four inches square, two and one half feet above ground, marked 3NP5-4437 and 4NP3-4436, in mound of earth and stone; identical with corner No. 4, of said Nonpareil No. 3, lode claim;

Thence, third course, south eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes east six hundred feet to corner No. 4, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 4NP5, 3NP7-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, fourth course, north three minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Nonpareil No. 5, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Nonpareil No. 6, lode claim at corner No. 1, identical with corner No. 1, of said Nonpareil No. 5, lode claim;

Thence, first course, north eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which location post bears north three minutes east twenty-four feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No. 2, identical with corner No. 2, of said Nonpareil No. 5, lode claim;

Thence, second course, north three minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 3, a pine post four inches square, two and one half feet above ground, marked 3NP6-4437 and 4NP4-4436, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, third course, south eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes east three hundred fifty-seven and eighty-eight-hundredths feet intersect the west side line of Little Zoe Fraction No. 1, lode claim, unsurveyed at north two degrees thirty-four minutes east four hundred nine and seventy-five-hundredths feet from the southwest corner; six hundred feet to corner No. 4, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 4NP6-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, fourth course, south three minutes west four hundred eighty-two and four-tenths feet intersect south end line of said Little Zoe Fraction No. 1, lode claim at south seventy-four degrees fifteen minutes forty seconds east two hundred seventy and two-tenths feet from the south-west corner; one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Nonpareil No. 6, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Nonpareil No. 7, lode claim at corner No. 1, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked LNP7, LNP8, LNP9-4437, in mound of earth and stone; from which the said Section corner bears north six degrees twenty minutes west one hundred eighty-five and four-tenths feet distant;

Thence, first course, north eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes west two hundred sixty-four and one-tenth feet to a point from which location post bears south three minutes west twenty-six and five-tenths feet distant; five hundred sixty-three and four-tenths feet to corner No. 2, identical with corner No. 1, of said Nonpareil No. 5, lode claim;

Thence, second course, south three minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 3, identical with corner No. 4, of said Nonpareil No. 5, lode claim;

Thence, third course, south eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes east five hundred sixty-three and four-tenths feet to corner No. 4, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 4NP7, 4NP9-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, fourth course, north three minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Nonpareil No. 7, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Nonpareil No. 8, lode claim at corner No. 1, identical with corner No. 1, of said Nonpareil No. 7, lode claim;

Thence, first course, north eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes west two hundred sixty-six and three-tenths feet to a point from which location post bears north three minutes east fourteen and one-tenth feet distant; five hundred sixty-three and four-tenths feet to corner No. 2, identical with corner No. 1, of said Nonpareil No. 5, lode claim;

Thence, second course, north three minutes east one thousand seventeen and six-tenths feet intersect south end line of said Little Zoe Fraction No. 1, lode claim at north seventy-four degrees fifteen minutes forty seconds west three hundred twenty-nine and eight-tenths feet from the southeast corner; one thousand forty-four and three-tenths feet to corner No. 3, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 3NP8-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, third course, south eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes east two hundred eighty-one and ninety-six-hundredths feet intersect west side line of the Little Zoe lode claim, unsurveyed, at north two degrees thirty minutes west four hundred sixty and seventy-three-hundredths feet from the southwest corner; three hundred twenty-two and six-tenths feet intersect east side line of said Little Zoe Fraction No. 1, lode claim at north two degrees thirty-four minutes east one hundred sixteen feet from the southeast corner; five hundred sixty-three and four-tenths feet to corner No. 4, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 4NP8-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, fourth course, south three minutes west five hundred thirty-three and fifty-seven-hundredths feet intersect the south end line of said Little Zoe lode claim at south seventy-four degrees fifteen minutes forty seconds east two hundred seventy-one and four-hundredths feet from the southwest corner; one thousand forty-four and three-tenths feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand forty-four and three-tenths feet in length along said Nonpareil No. 8, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Nonpareil No. 9, lode claim at corner No. 1, identical with corner No. 1, of said Nonpareil No. 7, lode claim;

Thence, first course, south eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes east three hundred feet to a point from which location post bears south three minutes west twenty-seven and three-tenths feet distant; five hundred ninety-nine and six-tenths feet to corner No. 2, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 2NP9-4457, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, second course, south three minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 3, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 3NP9-4437 and 4NP11-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, third course, north eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes west five hundred ninety-nine and six-tenths feet to corner No. 4, identical with corner No. 4, of said Nonpareil No. 7, lode claim;

Thence, fourth course, north three minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Nonpareil No. 9, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Nonpareil No. 10, lode claim at corner No. 1, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked LNP10, LNP11-4437, in mound of earth and stone, situate on line 3-4 of said Nonpareil No. 5, lode claim from which the said Section corner bears north twenty-seven degrees thirty-six minutes thirty seconds east one thousand eight hundred ninety-nine and eight-tenths feet distant;

Thence, first course, south three minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which location post bears north eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes west twenty-five and two-tenths feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No. 2, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 2NP10, 2NP11-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, second course, north eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes west one thousand four hundred ninety-nine feet to corner No. 3, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 3NP10-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, third course, north three minutes east six hundred feet to corner No. 4, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long marked 4NP10-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, fourth course, south eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes east one thousand four hundred ninety-nine feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand four hundred ninety-nine feet in length along said Nonpareil No. 10, vein or lode.

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Beginning for the description of the Nonpareil No. 11, lode claim at corner No. 1, identical with corner No. 1, of said Nonpareil No. 10, lode claim;

Thence, first course, south three minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which location post bears south eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes east twenty-four and eight-tenths feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No. 2, identical with corner No. 2, of said Nonpareil No. 10, lode claim;

Thence, second course, south eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes east one thousand four hundred ninety-nine and two-tenths feet to corner No. 3, a pine post four inches square, four and one half feet long, marked 3NP11-4437, in mound of earth and stone;

Thence, third course, north three minutes east six hundred feet to corner No. 4, identical with corner No. 3, of said Nonpareil No. 9, lode claim;

Thence, fourth course, north eighty-nine degrees fifty-seven minutes west one thousand four hundred ninety-nine and two-tenths feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning;

the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand four hundred ninety-nine and two-tenths feet in length along said Nonpareil No. 11, vein or lode; expressly excepting and excluding from these presents all that portion of the ground hereinbefore described embraced in said Little Zoe Fraction No. 1, and Little Zoe lode claims, unsurveyed, and also, all veins, lodes and ledges throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of such excluded ground; the premises herein granted containing one hundred thirty and seventy-eight thousandths acres.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore, pursuant to the laws aforesaid, hereby granted by the United States unto the said Western Divide Mining and Milling Company the said mining premises hereinbefore described, and not expressly excepted from these presents, and all that portion of the said veins, lodes, or ledges, and of all other veins, lodes, and ledges throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of the surface boundary lines of said granted premises in said survey extended downward vertically, although such veins, lodes, or ledges in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the vertical side lines of said premises; Provided, That the right of possession to such outside parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges shall be confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical planes drawn downward through the end lines of said survey so continued in their own direction that such planes will intersect such exterior parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges; And provided further, That nothing herein contained shall authorize the grantees herein to enter upon the surface of a claim owned or possessed by another.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said mining premises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said grantees above named and to its successors and assigns forever; subject, nevertheless, to the above-mentioned and to the following conditions and stipulations:

FIRST. That the premises hereby granted shall be held subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws, customs, and decisions of the courts. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

SECOND. That in the absence of necessary legislation by Congress, the Legislature of Nevada, may provide rules for working the mining claim or premises hereby granted, involving easements, drainage, and other necessary means to its complete development.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Warren G. Harding, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
