The district was discovered in June 1872 by Johnson and Murphy. The most promising locations are the Jackson and the McElheany, the former has a vein 3' width. The ore is principally argentiferous galena and carbonates. The geological formation is limestone. Granite Mountain district: Located 3 miles west of Dolly Varden; located in August by Wm. Murcey and Judge Reilly. Veins principally copper. A shaft sunk on the Emerald 50' shows promising bodies of copper ore.

DOLLY VARDEN DISTRICT for 1875-1876: Located about 60 miles south of Toano; scarcity of water; considerable work has been done on different claims.
