Hard to make any sense out of what's been done. New work appears to have been a sampling project as there are several seemingly new back hoe trenches & cat cuts. Fairly new claim group "Chink" claim in canyon. Probably go along with latest work.

El Paso Gulch area: Numerous adits scattered up Gulch on both sides. Workings appear to be from a few 10's of feet in length up to 200-300 ft. in length. all were driven in heavily Fe stained rock.

Range front between Sodarisi & Spring Canyons newly staked. Soda claims, John D. Woods claimant, Winn., NV, Feb. 25, 1985. Spring Canyon: A few but very small prospects up Spring Canyon.
