ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Small knob of silicified limestone, thin-bedded, highly contorted, jasper-gossan lenses along N70°W - 70°SW structure, forms prominent black-stained ridge along south side of the knob, shaft in wash, s. side of knob, sunk on structure, exposes jasper-gossan zone about 50 wide. "Bluff", to NE of mine is composed of massive, bleached limestone (marble), underlain by a shale unit.
