DEVELOPMENT: Recent dozer work in the vicinity of a large older adit that was the main workings..drilling and road building within the last four years.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drilling and restaking by Robinson Industries and Assoc.

GEOLOGY: The old SW bearing adit was driven on a shear within the meta-andesites of Permian age which is partly filled with oxidized and brecciated quartz vein material. The mineralization extends into the metasediments along the margin of the vein and includes copper sulfides and oxides as well as possible silver lead sulfides. Drill core has been stored in a trailer on the site and is assumed to have come from the local drill sites.
