Location

History and production Tungsten veins were discovered on property in 1910. Little work was done until 1918. The mine was operated during World War I. After the war it was inactive until 1935 when it was reopened. Closed in October 1942.

Type Deposit (Geology) Five veins comprise the mineral area. All are roughly parallel striking N. 20 E., dipping 55-60 E. The ore occurs in quartz filled veins ranging from a few inches to several feet in width. The country rock is coarse grained microrite-biotite granite.

Mine Workings Mine working ore comprised of 2 main levels 200 ft. and 700 ft. long and an inclined shaft sunk to a depth of 80 feet.
