GEOLOGY: Bleached-white to buff colored-limestone with sugary texture.  
#4 occurrence of Sayeed.

In the "open adit" above road, one west side of gully was at the mouth of adit - a quartz sericite, chlorite rock associated with an aplitic? dike(may be a sill). Quartz/sericite/chlorite rock contained limonite after sulfides (pyrite?), pyrite, fluorite?, hubnerite? Zone 6"-8" wide, strikes N5°W, dips 73° SE.

REMARKS: Samples: RBJ 4-80 UV Lamp showed no scheelite.
