LOCATION

Section 27, Township 21 North, Range 69 East. Regan Mining District, White Pine County, Nevada, 65 miles east of Cherry Creek, Nevada, via country road. Elevation 7800 to 8600 feet.

GEOLOGY

The rock formation is granite, traversed by 5 quarts veins ranging in width from 6 inches to 3 feet wide. Crystalline aggregates of hubmerite occur sporadically distributed in the quarts.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Principal work done has been through 2 tunnels - 280 and 560 feet long, both driven on the voin. The 280 foot tunnel is a cross-cut and did not reach its objective. The 580 foot tunnel was driven on the vein and about 3500 tons of ore extracted and milled.

The U.S. Bureau of Mines made a number of diamond drill holes and an estimate of termage ranges up to 20,000 tens of .5% WOz.
