Location:

9 miles from Eastgate, Nevada. Probably in the Eastgate Mining District. This and the surrounding area has produced gold, silver and lead.

H.T.C. has 13 patented claims in the Fairview Mining District which is about 20 miles from the Eastgate area.

History:

Dr. Shambaugh reports that 9 of the claims would be open pit mining with no overburden. Assays indicate gold from 50¢ to \$38.85 per yard and silver from .08¢ oz. to 12¢ oz. per yard. 100 million yards in sight. 1/2 mile of drifting on 3 levels. Good roads, 7 miles off the oiled highway. Plenty of water available.

Report:

From the meager information given by Dr. Shambaugh it may be more of a hydraulic - placer operation than an open pit. Geologist E. L. Stephenson will contact Dr. Shambaugh in person at Fallon and make further inquiries into the property.

GOLD AND SILVER PROPERTY AVAILABLE FOR SALE

Located 70 miles east of Fallon, Nevada, 9 miles from Eastgate, Nevada in what is known as the Buffalo Hump mining area. I have available 15 claims in the same formation. Nine of these claims are strictly open pit and 6 are hard rock.

Assays have shown no arsenic, sulphur or carbonaceous materials. The 9 claims, which are open pit, would require no stripping from the top down.

Oiled road all the way except for the last 7 miles, which is a well maintained country road.

According to hydraulic engineers there is plenty of water available a short distance from the claims which can be obtained by drilling. The elevation of the main hill is 6,500 feet.

The operation could well handle a 500 ton mill on the property.

The last three reputable engineers that have looked over the property estimate there is about 100 million yards in sight. Over 1/2 mile of drifting, at three levels, has been completed.

Assays taken over the past several years indicate that gold, silver and titanium are the three main minerals. Assays have indicated the following: Gold, from 50¢ to \$38.85 per yard; Silver, from .8 oz. to 12 oz. per yard; Titanium, from 1% to 1-1/2%.

There is also a large deposit of Silicon that shows 91.8% pure.
