DEVELOPMENT: Two large adits...upper is reported to be 500 feet long the lower 1800 feet..no usable roads.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None but restaked by J. Fallini (?)

GEOLOGY: Adits were driven as cross-cuts under a silicified zone in rhyolite that stands out as a rib above the workings. Both workings are still tracked and are standing well without timber. Upper dump has minor quartz veinlets within material scattered on dump with some pyrite. Lower workings were not mined for over 1000 feet..access to the remaining portions were restricted by minor flooding. The last material from the lower adit showed some quartz with pyrite but no other mineralization.
