Undeveloped but very promising, and belongs with the Duncan property, (Nevada-Eldorado) on which you already have information sheet.

5 Unpatented claims. Three of them are shown on the Duncan map (which you already have) at the extreme left hand, dotted in in red. (San Juan, San Juan No. 2 and Wolf.)

There is a large strong persistent vein running thro' this ground, which we would certainly want if we acquired the Duncan and Bergman properties. It undoubtedly contains two or more gold shoots and is of the same character as the Duncan ground. A close study of the geology might show that it is the same big vein as Duncan's thrown to the South by a North-South Fault. I cannot make even a guess as to the probability of this as I gave it no study. It simply suggests itself to me through similarity of the veins and their position.

After seeing most of the ground, inspecting his various small pits, open cuts and tunnels, which show the characteristic oxidized, silicious gold bearing vein material of the district, I was surprised when he took me into a forty foot tunnel on the East end of the San Juan claim and showed me a one to two foot vein of zinc-lead-copper-iron sulphides assaying better than four dollars gold and silver. Not any great amount of development work has been done, but it is an exceedingly promising showing.

His Lawson and Eagle's Nest claims were taken partly on account of water sullpy, which he developed to the extent of 4500 gallons per day with but little work along a slip or contact in the porphyries. The chances are good here for developing 50,000 gallons
