SUBJECT: 5 Patented Mining Claims - 4 Claims in the
Shannon Group and the King Lode

Owner: Mr. William M. Brown
1510 Spanish Oaks
San Antonio, Texas 78213,

Location: Eldorado Mining District in Clark County, Nevada
near Nelson, about 45 miles Southeast of Las Vegas.

History: The above group of claims have never been mined
commercially. The present owner believes that
the many owners involved retarded the development
of these claims.

The Eldorado Mining District was an active gold
mining district, producing predominately gold and
silver.

In this mining district none of the mines went to
any great depth. Mr. Walter M. Brown, a mining
engineer, reports that, "Eldorado Canyon is badly
broken by faults and igneous intrusions and its
possibility at depth are unproven" and he believes
that the ores are by no means exhausted.

Mr. Brown quotes from the Ransome Report from
U.S.G.S. Bulletin No. 303, as follows: "The
development of these mines under a single manage-
ment and by modern methods constitute a problem
that is well worthy of careful consideration."

Report: The patented claims may not be worthy of consider-
ation at this time. However, a large block of claims
in the Eldorado Mining District may be worthy of
geological survey.

Maps and general information and Brown's geological
report are attached.
