DEVELOPMENT: Small shaft, several adits and prospects

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: An adit follows a vein that strikes N10°E, 75°E, in altered andesite. Iron stained quartz stringers along with bleached and agrillized gouge fill the 14" vein. The sample which was chipped from the vein is in part vuggy, with open space fillings and coated with manganese. Mineralization included clots of galena and gray wispy streaks of unidentified sulfides. Nearby prospects include a shallow shaft and adit along with small diggings that explore narrow veins in shears. Remnants of an old cabin and vestiges of a road from the west can still be seen. Drilling within the area has occurred within the last five years.
